

Today, Caitlin is passionate about unlocking human potential through educating and investing in underutilised, high-potential and high-value talent – often women and children – in order to create a better world. Caitlin is also currently working on the launch of Xchange, an education and investment platform for female entrepreneurs, both existing and aspiring, to support them in establishing globally scalable technology businesses and to smash through the glass ceiling.




