She is the founder and CEO of Tech Ready Women and the creator of the Tech Ready Program—a ten-week accelerator specifically designed for non-tech female founders who want to step confidently into the tech space. It was recently awarded Startup Accelerator of the year at the 2017 Australasian Startup Awards.

Tech Ready Women's mission is to provide women with tech and business education, access to world class mentors and connections to startup communities, enabling them to create the businesses of tomorrow.

Christie is also CEO of Hatching Lab, an innovation and tech partner to startups and corporates focusing on innovation training. In 2015 Christie co-founded of Poppy Renegade, a movement to empower women to stand tall in the workplace.

She has created multiple ventures in the tech field, including a dating app named Fancied, which was voted number 1 dating app in Australia by Famous magazine. Startup Daily recently nominated Christie as one of the Top 50 Australian Women in Tech and she has appeared extensively in the media including interviews with Ch 7 Sunrise, Sky News Business, Alan Kohler Qantas Talking Business podcast and Mark Bouris The Mentor, along with writing guest articles for a variety of publications including Kochies Business Builders, Women's Agenda, SmartCompany, Collective Hub, Startup Daily, Lifehacker, Anthill Online and Women Love Tech.

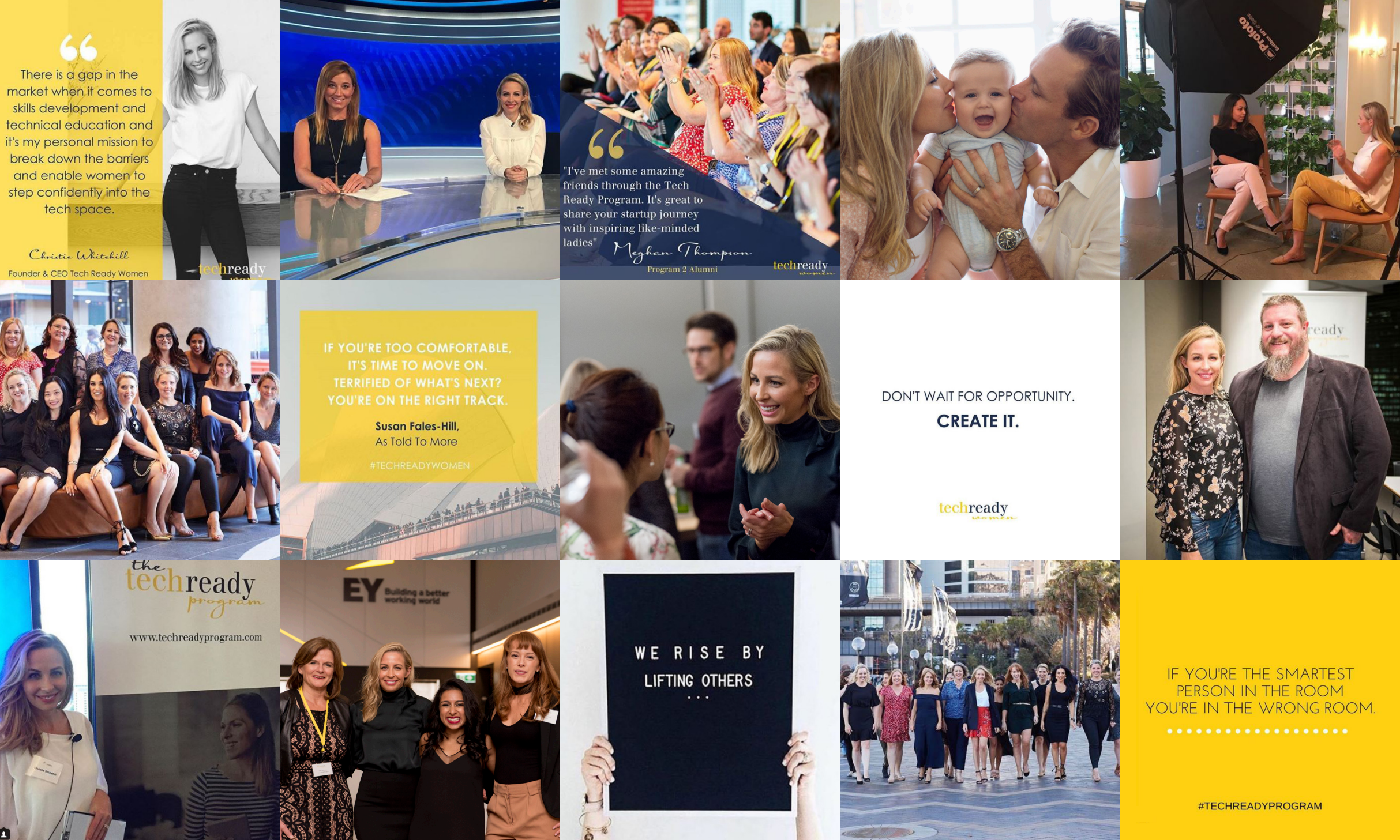

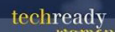
